

COURSE REGULATIONS

Of the public limited company **Airsafetytraining.com**

Article 1 : Participation

Participation in a training programme, course or activity is at the sole risk of the participant. Airsafetytraining.com is not liable for any damage caused, for whatever reason, to the property of the participant/third party, as well as for any personal injury.

Article 2 : Proof of identity

Every participant is required to submit valid proof of identity on commencement of the training course.

Article 3 : Following instructions

If the (course) participant does not comply with the (safety) instructions of the instructor/trainer, the (course) participant can be excluded from the training programme, course or activity with immediate effect, without the course fee being refunded.

Article 4 : Personal risk

If the (course) participant endangers himself/herself or others, the (course) participant can be excluded from the training programme, course or activity with immediate effect, without the course fee being refunded.

Article 5 : PPE

The (course) participant is obliged to have in their possession and to use personal protection equipment. This personal protection equipment comprises a safety helmet, safety goggles, safety gloves and safety footwear as a minimum, as long as the training activity requires these.

Article 6 : Punctuality

The (course) participant is required to be punctual.

Article 7 : Following the lessons

The (course) participant is required to follow all the lessons. If he/she fails to do so, Airsafetytraining.com may exclude the (course) participant from the examinations, without any right to the course fee being refunded.

Article 8 : Results

Airsafetytraining.com does not have any influence on the outcome of an examination or test.

Article 9 : No smoking

Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking zones.

Article 10: Specific requirements

For all course participants personal protection equipment is compulsory for the practical courses, that is, safety helmet, safety goggles, safety gloves and safety footwear.

All course participants are required to have valid proof of identity.

Article 11 : approved equipment

If practical courses take place on the client's site, using client's equipment (such as fork-lift trucks, aerial work platforms, overhead cranes, brush cutters, etc.), the client is obliged to ensure that the equipment is approved and is accompanied by inspection reports.
